**FINAL DECISION AND ORDER**

**ISSUE:**

Did the Board improperly determine that the student’s behavior was not a manifestation of his disability?

**PROCEDURAL HISTORY/SUMMARY:**

The Student is entitled to receive a free and appropriate public education in the least restrictive environment as defined in the Individuals with Disabilities Education Improvement Act (“IDEA”) §20 U. S. C. 1401 et seq. and Connecticut General Statutes §10-76a et seq. The Parents filed the Due Process Hearing Complaint on November 14, 2019. The Hearing Officer was appointed on November 18, 2019. At the pre-hearing conference was scheduled for on November 27, 2019. The Parents withdrew their complaint on November 27, 2019.
